# AMANDA OUTCALT: ROUTINE EXAMINATION

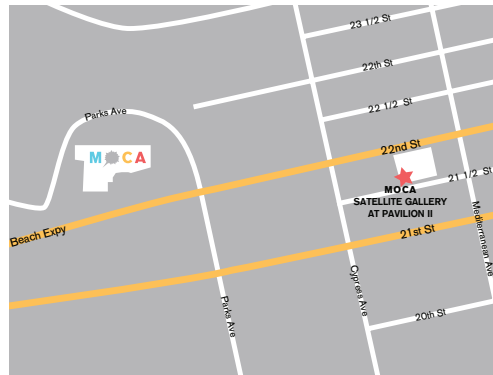

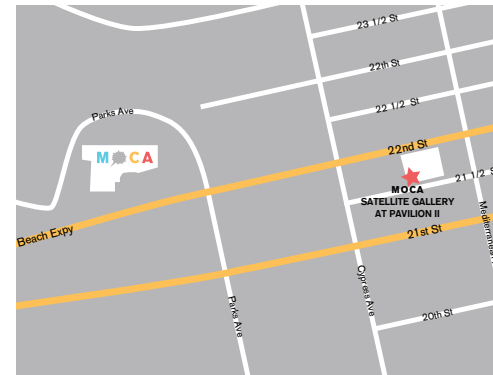
